

### **As writers...**

We will be writing our final assessed pieces across a range of genres, applying all of the skills we have developed throughout Year 6. We will focus on writing with accuracy, creativity and control, using ambitious vocabulary, varied sentence structures and effective punctuation to create engaging and purposeful writing.

### **As scientists...**

We will continue learning about animals including humans, focusing on the circulatory system.
