Market	This is where lots of people can buy and sell items. They are usually placed on stalls.
Tudor	This shows a period of time in history when the Tudor family reigned.
Bridges	Bridges are often used to cross from one place to another.
River	This is naturally flowing water that leads to either a lake or the sea.
Aerial view	This is when you look at something from above.
Gable ends	This is the side of a house that is pointed at the top. Usually in the shape of a triangle.
