

Literacy

As **creative** readers and writers we are learning to...

Reading

Through our power of reading story telling we will join in with stories and rhymes, anticipating key events and phrases. We will demonstrate an awareness of how stories are structured.

Writing

To practice tracing over the letters from our name. To begin to copy our name cards and form recognisable letters.

Phonics

As **enthusiastic** readers we are... learning these **Phase 1** (letters and sounds)

Aspect 3. General sound discrimination
- body percussion.

Purpose -

To develop awareness of sounds and rhythms.

To distinguish between sounds and to remember patterns of sound.

To talk about sounds that we make with our bodies and what sounds mean.

Tuning into sounds activities - Listening to music, Roly poly song and action games.

Listening and remembering sounds activities - Follow the sounds, Noisy Neighbours 1.

Talking about sounds activities - Words and sounds, Pied piper, Noisy Neighbours 2

Communication and Language

As **developing** linguists we are learning to...

Listening and Attention

Sit appropriately and listen to others during carpet time and small key group activities. We will learn to put our hands up and wait for our turn to talk.

To listen and join in with repeated refrains and phrases in stories and rhymes.

Understanding

Respond to simple instructions involving a sequence

Such as tidy where we're playing, get our coats on and line up by the door to go outside.

Speaking

Use talk to connect ideas during play and extend vocabulary in explaining what's happening and what might happen next.

Physical Development

As **fit, healthy and active** children we are learning to

Moving and handling

We will begin our daily 'Write dance' sessions where we will learn how to hold our writing equipment in a three fingered tripod grip correctly. We will use gross motor movement to draw circles, lines and patterns on large paper as instructed in the music.

We will use our out door field area to run skilfully and negotiate our space successfully adjusting speed or direction to avoid obstacles.

Health and self-care

We will independently put our coats, waterproofs and wellies on to access all weather outdoor play

Maths

As **enquiring** mathematicians we are learning to...

NUMBER count reliably

- Demonstrate an interest in number problems
- Recite numbers in order to 10 and beyond.
- To begin to show an awareness of numbers 1-10 in the environment.
- To begin to correctly order numbers 1-5 on a number line
- To sometimes match numeral and quantity correctly.
- To use the language more, less and the same when looking at two groups of objects

SHAPE, SPACE AND MEASURE

- We will look at ice as a solid form and what happens to ice over a period of time if left in warm conditions. We will discuss how ice is formed.
- We will use language to talk about size weight and capacity.
- We will use our problem solving skills to establish how we can release the penguins frozen in the ice shapes by using a variety of resources.

As **inquisitive** learners we will be finding out about...
