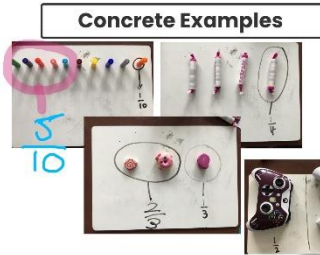
They continue to fill me with pride by their engagement and the quality of work! I absolutely love seeing the work they have produced...



Concrete Examples

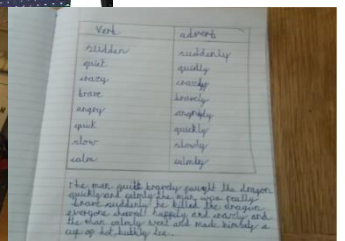
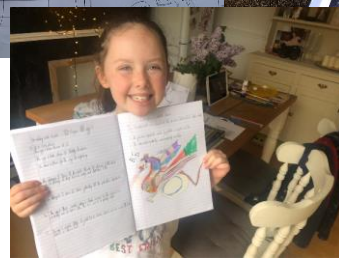
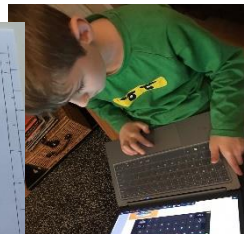
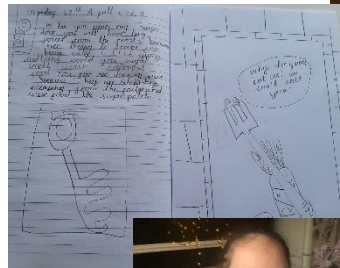


In **maths** this week we have been looking at fractions. We have found concrete examples of fractions in our homes!

Our **SPaG** focus has been the suffix 'ly'. In **English** we have adapted the work of authors to create our own versions of their stories... for example Skeleton Keys!

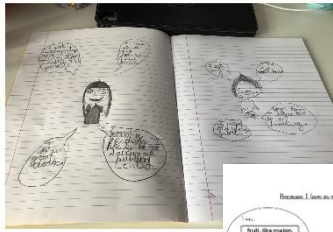

I like to be a doctor with my Dad, Mum and sister.

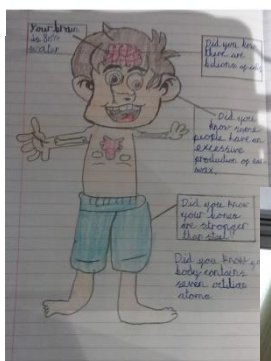
I like lots of strips of material, made into a skirt.

Some of the things I like to do are hunt and make baskets.

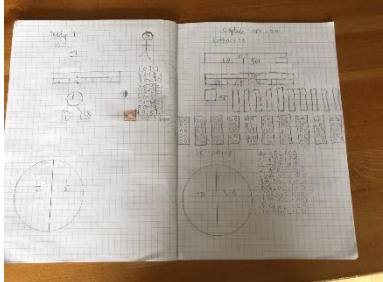
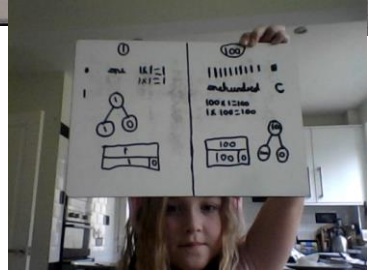
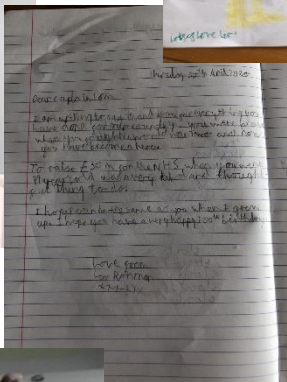
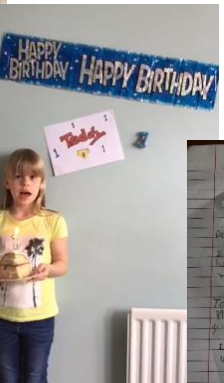
Our **Geography** work this week has been looking at the Rainforest Yanomami tribe and comparing their lifestyle to our own.
