HUGE congratulations to Mrs Garbett!

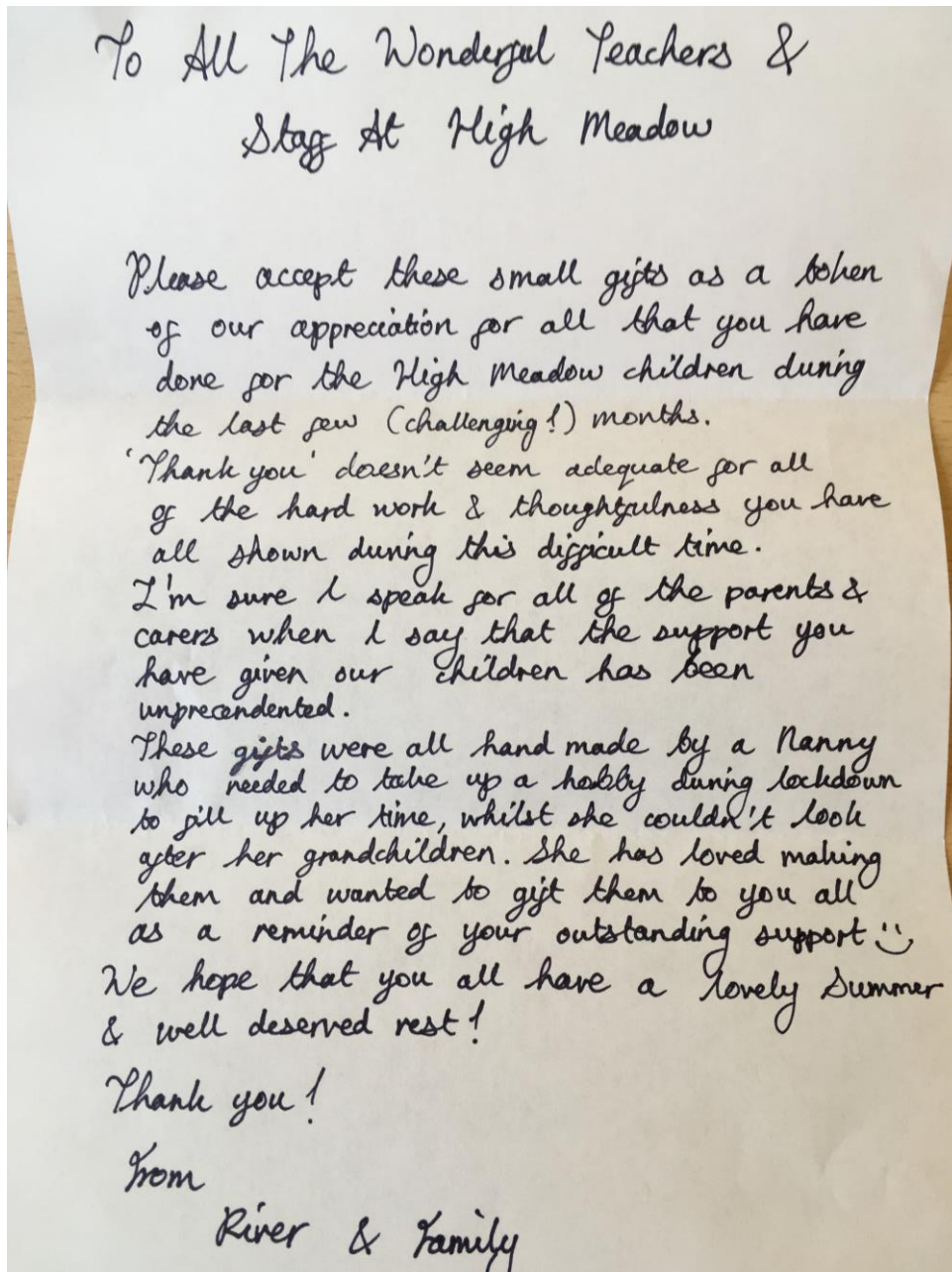

We can all help control the virus if we all stay alert. This means you must:

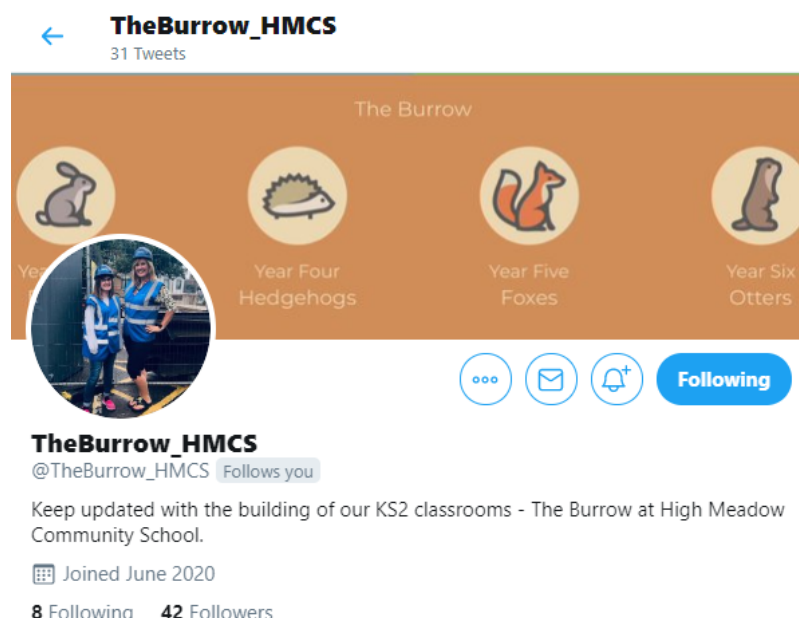
1. Stay at home as much as possible
