## Key vocabulary

<b>Charcoal</b>	This is a black solid material usually in the form of a cylinder.
<b>Chalk</b>	This is a soft white material usually in the form of a cylinder.
<b>Pastel</b>	These are used in art frequently. They are in the form of a stick and made from powered paint and wax.
<b>Graphite</b>	This solid material is usually found in pencils.
<b>Erasers</b>	This is also known as a rubber. This allows you to erase a mark or line you have drawn.

## Process



Blind drawing of a feather.



Drawing with pencils.



Using charcoal and erasers.

Collage feathers and stick them onto the bird.
