Corona Virus Appendix
September 2020

- Children showing symptoms of coronavirus must not come into school
 - High Temperature
 - A new persistent cough
 - A loss or change to sense of smell or taste
- Children will be expected to stay within their class group bubbles during break and lunch time periods.
- Children will listen to and follow adult instructions.
- Children will sit at table or on mat as instructed by staff.
- Children will use antibacterial hand gel on entry to school and throughout the day as directed by the class staff.
- Regular handwashing will still be expected.
- Children will use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze into, the tissue must be binned and hands washed straight away.
- Children must refrain from touching other children and adults not in the bubble.
- Children must use only the pencils they bring into school and not share resources.
- Children must socially distance from each other where possible and practicable.
- Children must be able to independently unwrap their own lunch items.
- School staff will contact parents of any children who are finding it difficult to comply with the stringent guidance and they will be asked to collect their child immediately for health and safety reasons.
- Any child spitting at other children or staff will be excluded from school for a period of up to 3 days due to the serious risk of spreading the disease.
- Any child developing symptoms of coronavirus during the school day will be isolated immediately and their parent will be contacted to come and collect the child. The family will be advised to isolate for 10/14 days and arrange a test for the child. School should be advised of the results of the test.
- Key stage 1 and 2 children will clean their own area after eating their lunch.



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
