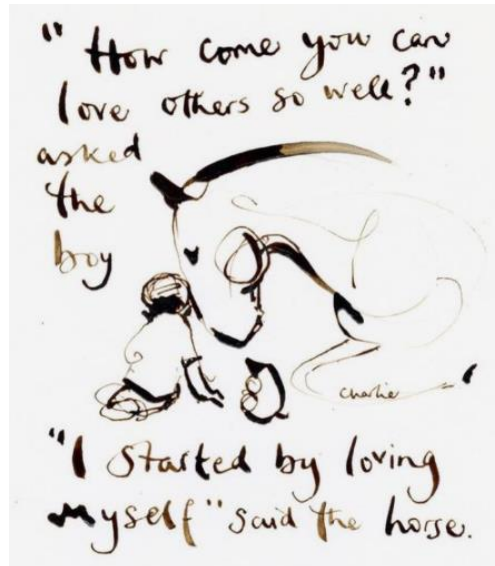

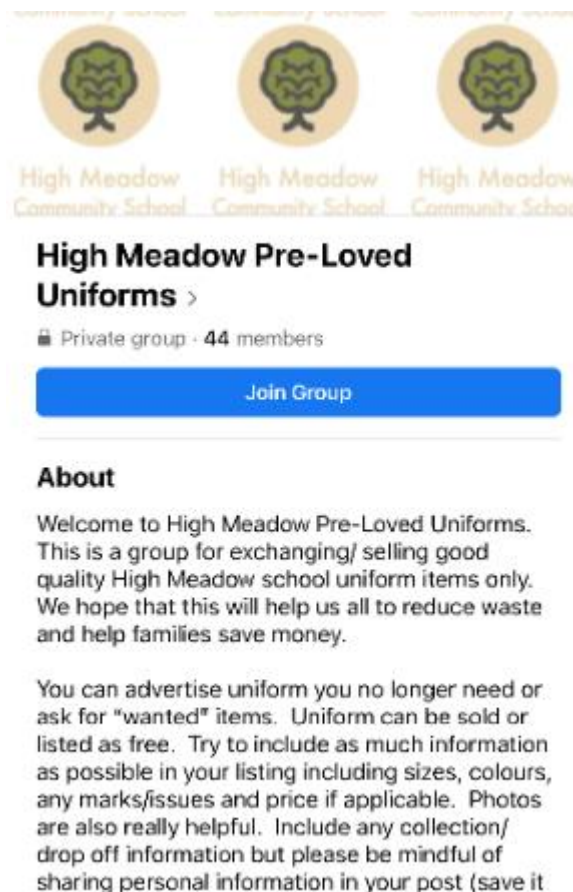

Keeping Everyone Safe in School – A Gentle Reminder

Daily cases are continuing to rise and many local schools are closing class bubbles, with Shustoke closing their whole school for 10 days. It has been identified that the source of many of the positive cases are coming from dance schools and other clubs. We only have a week and a half left of this term and any positive cases now would mean that a whole class would miss the final weeks of the term which would be so sad after such a challenging time! So please, please, please continue to follow the COVID advice to keep everyone safe.

COVID 19 symptoms in your child

Any child displaying symptoms of COVID19 must be sent home to be tested. As we are not medical professionals, it is difficult for us to determine whether a child has a cold or COVID symptoms so, to keep the whole school community safe we WILL call you and ask you to take your child to be tested if they show ANY ONE of the symptoms outlined on the NHS website.

These are ...

a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)

a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)

a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms. If your child is showing these symptoms at home, please do not send them into school.





If a child tests positive for COVID 19 then the **WHOLE** class bubble will need to self-isolate for 10 days. Please ensure you have emergency plans in place if this does happen. Remote teaching, will then take place and your child will be expected to engage in online learning for the whole period of isolation, unless they become too unwell to do so.
